VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

The mission of the MMLT is to preserve, restore and legally protect, private land areas and places having exceptional ecological, scientific, natural, aesthetic, and historic value, for the benefit of present and future generations.

PROPERTY MONITOR

Description:

Every property which is under the oversight of MMLT has a Stewardship Monitoring Plan. The Monitoring Plan outlines the specific purposes of monitoring the respective property such as:

- Checking for disturbances such as tree cutting, bark stripping, trail obstructions, plant collecting, campfires, garbage, vandalism, etc.
- Checking for unauthorized uses such as poaching, hunting, trapping, dirt biking, unauthorized vehicle access, etc.
- Recommending remediation such as fencing, posts, signage, trail improvements, clean-up, etc.

Each Property Monitor will be provided with a Monitoring Checklist to help carry out the inspection of the property and to report on any changes since the last monitoring visit.

The Property Monitor will be provided with orientation by a board member or MMLT staff.

Skills:

- Understanding of a property's Stewardship Monitoring Plan and Checklist.
- Record-keeping experience.
- Physical capabilities to make onsite inspections of properties.
